******* IMPORTANT REMINDERS*******

1. Students may enter only ONE category of competition in strings on the competition day (i.e., MTNA or Mountain State or Adagio Strings).
2. *****Application Form and Repertoire List must be complete and accurate –**

3. A student requiring an accompanist is fully responsible for hiring and paying his or her accompanist. Staff accompanists are NOT provided at the state level for any of the competitions.
4. The accompanist's name **MUST** be indicated on the application form, along with his or her contact number and e-mail address. Please secure an accompanist BEFORE submitting the application form.
5. Teachers who enter students **MUST** register for the convention and may be asked to assist with monitoring, registration, or other duties set forth by the Competitions Chair.
6. Teachers should send in **ONE check** for all his or her students' entries combined.
7. Teachers MTNA active membership dues **MUST** be paid **BEFORE** submission of the application. Entrants will be assessed a \$150 nonmember teacher fee if the membership is not paid for the 2017–2018 membership year.
8. Students must have studied with the presenting teacher for at least six of the last nine months preceding the event. In the event of illness or relocation out of the area, the new teacher may present the student with written authorization by the previous teacher.
9. **Students and accompanists should plan to reserve the ENTIRE day on Saturday, November 2, 2019** (e.g., 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.) for the competition performance. Specific scheduling requests will NOT be honored.
10. Keep one copy of this application for your records.

REPERTOIRE INFORMATION: Pieces must be slow works.

Please e-mail the repertoire list to the Competitions Chair. Be sure to provide complete and accurate information relating to the following:

- Complete titles
 - Individual movements within a multi-movement piece, if applicable (for example, 2nd mvt.: Adagio) – be sure to include tempo markings (i.e., Lento, Largo, Adagio, etc.)
 - Composer names (first and last names) •
 - Accurate performance timing for each piece.
- While there is no minimum time requirement, the maximum performance time limits are: 20 minutes for both Junior High and Senior High categories.
